Clark — 8 Mar 1884 (p. 10) — Marriage — Clark married

Clark — 13 Mar 1884 (p. 10) — Marriage — Clark and John F. married

Clark — 1889 (p. 106) — Visit/Family reference — “John and Aunt Clark with us a while tonight”

Clendenin — 20 Dec 1885 (p. 77) — Burial — John Clendenin buried

Cox — 1 Feb 1889 (p. 109) — Death/Burial — Mr. Cox's little baby buried

D

Dortch — 15 Jun 1887 (p. 99) — Birth — “another man child born to us all right” (George Dortch family)

Dortch — 12 Oct 1885 (p. 71) — Baptism — Ella Dortch baptized

E

Ellis — 3 Feb 1887 (p. 92) — Baptism — Mary Ellis from Arkansas baptized

F

Finch — 1 Mar 1885 (p. 49) — Residence/Return — John Finch returned from Arkansas

H

Herd — 9 Oct 1883 (p. 100) — Death/Burial — Burial of Herd's baby

L

Linzie — 20 Feb 1886 (p. 86) — Burial — Mr. Linzie buried

Lofton — 12 Oct 1885 (p. 71) — Baptism — Sister Lofton of Union City baptized

Lowery — 31 May 1885 (p. 58) — Baptism — Sid Lowery and wife baptized

M

Moody — 23 Nov 1882 (p. 55) — Death/Burial — Three of Green Moody's children buried

N

Nash — 21 Mar 1885 (p. 51) — Burial — Ed Nash's wife buried

O

Osborne — 31 May 1885 (p. 58) — Religious Rite — Bro. Osborne performed baptisms

P

Parker — 25 Nov 1882 (p. 56) — Baptism — Hud Parker and wife baptized

Parker — 1 Apr 1885 (p. 46) — Death — Bud Parker deceased

Parker — 12 Oct 1885 (p. 71) — Baptism — Bro. James Parker and wife baptized

Perry — 24 Mar 1885 (p. 51) — Marriage — Tommie and Ella Perry married

R

Roberts — 16 Oct 1883 (p. 101) — Death — One of Roberts' men at the stove factory died

Roberts — 20 Oct 1883 (p. 102) — Death/Funeral Preparation — Assisted washing and dressing Roberts after death

S

Stem — 4 Mar 1883 (p. 71) — Marriage — Emerson Stem married

W

Walls — 8 Oct 1882 (pp. 49–50) — Death — Pete Walls' baby died

Wilse — 7 Feb 1889 (p. 109) — Baptism — Mr. Wilse baptized
